Lexington District One board candidate forums start Sunday

LEXINGTON, S.C. — The League of Women Voters and Lexington County School District One will hold a school board candidate forum on Sunday, Sept. 27, 2020, at 3 p.m., in the auditorium of Building One of Central Services located at 100 Tarrar Springs Road in Lexington, South Carolina.

The 90-minute-long meeting will not be open to the public as the district put some safeguards in place to keep the candidates and LWV moderator and timekeepers safe while complying with the CDC's COVID-19 masking and social distancing recommendations.

Candidate forums are essential because, on General Election Day, Nov. 3, 2020, Lexington County School District One voters will choose four individuals for four at-large seats on the Board of Trustees.

Two of the original 12 candidates withdrew, leaving 10 candidates: Mike Anderson, Anne Marie Green, Mike Griffin, Kathy Henson, Jason Hinton, Reese McCurdy, Brent M. Powers, Travis Price, Chris Rice, and Chelsea Snelgrove. Mr. McCurdy already had a commitment and is unable to attend this forum.
