LexLeads—CREW (Creating Relationships, Exploring Within)

RBHS students are placed in small groups; each group is called a CREW. Led by an adult, these groups foster relationship-building and provide academic and emotional support. Each CREW meets weekly, and students focus on academic drive, character development and establishing shared understandings. The CREW experience helps students build confidence in a safe environment that allows them to learn, reflect and identify their own quality work.

LexLearns—Tools for Measuring Learning

Learning Targets are one of many tools students use to measure their learning. Teachers work with students to set learning targets for standards in each subject. Clearly defined objectives and strategies for success enable students to track their progress for understanding and mastery. Learning is further defined by formative assessments and the feedback they provide.

LexLearns—EL Education

RBHS is one of two EL Education High Schools in South Carolina. EL Education focuses on self-discovery and helps students take responsibility for their learning. Project-based learning experiences called learning expeditions enable students to engage in real work for a real audience. Research, fieldwork, experts, and reading and writing are all used to produce quality work. This type of learning fosters critical thinking and encourages students to take active roles in their classrooms and communities.

LexLearns—Flexible Modular Scheduling

Flexible Modular Scheduling, or Flex Mod, divides instructional time into 20 minute modules or MODS. Student schedules include teacher-designed instructional time and independent learning time.

Students make individual choices about how to use their independent learning time to best meet their instructional needs by meeting with a teacher one-on-one, studying independently, researching in the learning commons or working collaboratively with a small group of classmates on a project.

LexLearns—Centers for Advanced Study

The Center for Media Arts, Design and Production and The Center for Law and Global Policy Development provide honors level and advanced placement level courses designed to connect learning and hands-on experiences within these fields. They focus on preparation for post-secondary study and careers through specialized research projects, internships and externships. These two-year centers are open to juniors and seniors across the district.

LexLives— Student Wellness

Both students and staff learn about and engage in healthy living through participation in the School Health Team. RBHS also participates in service activities that promote healthy choices and raise awareness for various diseases and health issues.
